

EMPLOYEES' FEDERATION HELD ON 23RD APRIL, 2011 IN DR. BHIM RAO
AMBEDKAR BHAWAN, RANI JHANSI ROAD, NEW DELHI.**

The biennial convention of All India ESIC SC/ST Officers' and Employees' Federation was held on 23rd April, 2011 in Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Bhawan, Rani Jhansi Road, New Delhi. Representatives from following Regions attended the meeting.

On the outset the Senior executives of the Federation were welcomed on stage. Subsequently, veteran activists of Federation were welcomed on stage. The house welcomed all the dignitaries by giving a welcome buckeye.

The house began its meeting by paying rich tributes to Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar by showering flowers on his portrait.

With the permission of chair the proceeding of meeting started.

At the outset Shri Manbir Singh Godra, Additional Secretary General in his speech in the august house gave a glimpse of initial days of Service Association activities/functioning. He gave a description of how the associations and federation came into existence. He gave a brief description of functioning of the Federation.

Shri R.N. Mallick, Asstt. Secretary General (East Zone) gave his report on functioning of Federation in East Zone. Shri Mallick gave the glimpses of how he has strengthened the functioning of regional associations in East Zone and assured the august house to be rest assured of good working by local and regional units and representative of Federation of East Zone.

Shri B. Gnana Kumar, Asstt. Secretary General (South Zone) gave his report on functioning of Federation in South Zone. Shri Kumar also gave the glimpses of how the Regional units and Zonal members of Federation are doing their work sincerely. He emphasized to strengthen the Federation at Central level.

Shri M.G. Sorate, Asstt. Secretary General (West Zone) gave his report on functioning of Federation in West Zone. Shri Sorate raised the issue of lack of interest on functioning at central level. He demanded conducting of regular zonal and national EC meeting of Federation.

After adopting the audited final accounts the President declared the house to be dissolved.


The House nominated Shri Din Dayal, Retired Joint Director (Finance) D(M) D as Election Commissioner and the house was adjourned for a Lunch Break.
